

NEOMYCIN OINTMENT

Neomycin Sulfate B.P.

Composition:

Neomycin Sulfate B.P.
Eq. to Neomycin 1.0% w/w
Ointment base q.s.

Indication: Neomycin, an antibiotic, is used to prevent or treat skin infections caused by bacteria. It is not effective against fungal or viral infections.

Uses: Neomycin comes as a cream and ointment applied to the skin. Neomycin is generally used one to three times a day. Follow the instructions on your prescription label carefully and ask your doctor or pharmacist to explain any part you do not understand. Use neomycin exactly as directed.

Do not use more or less, or use it more frequently than prescribed by your doctor. Clean the infected area thoroughly, let it dry, and gently rub in the medication until most of it disappears. Use only enough medication to cover the affected area. You should wash your hands after applying the medication.

Side effects:

Neomycin may cause side effects. If you experience any of the following symptoms, call your doctor immediately:

- * Irritation
- * Burning
- * Redness
- * Rash
- * Itching
- * Hearing Difficulty
- * Decreased urination

Warnings:

Burning, redness, or skin irritation may occur. If any of these effects persist or worsen, inform your doctor or pharmacist immediately.

If your doctor has prescribed this medication, remember that he or she determined that the benefit to you outweighs the risk of side effects. Many people who use this medication do not experience serious side effects.

Precautions:

Before using this product, tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are allergic to any of its ingredients, or if you have other allergies. This product may contain inactive ingredients that can cause allergic reactions or other problems. Talk to your pharmacist for more details.

Before using this medication, tell your doctor or pharmacist your medical history, especially regarding: other skin conditions (e.g., eczema, viral skin infections such as shingles, chickenpox, cold sores). Before undergoing surgery, tell your doctor or dentist that you are using this product

During pregnancy, this medication should be used only when clearly necessary. Discuss the risks and benefits with your doctor.

It is not known whether this drug passes into breast milk. Consult your doctor before breastfeeding.

Do not use if:

You have a known sensitivity or allergy to any ingredient. This medication should not be used if you are allergic to any of its ingredients. Please inform your doctor or pharmacist if you have ever experienced such an allergy.

If you experience an allergic reaction, stop using this medication and inform your doctor or pharmacist immediately.

Pregnancy and breastfeeding:

Certain medicines should not be used during pregnancy or breastfeeding. However, other medicines can be used safely during pregnancy or breastfeeding, provided the benefits to the mother outweigh the risks to the fetus. Always inform your doctor if you are pregnant or planning to become pregnant before using any medication.

How can this medicine affect other medicines:

It is important to tell your doctor or pharmacist what medicines you are already taking, including those bought without a prescription and herbal medicines, before you start treatment with this medicine. Similarly, check with your doctor or pharmacist before using any new medicines while using this one, to ensure that the combination is safe.

If this cream is used on extensive areas of skin, it may be absorbed into the bloodstream. If significant amounts of neomycin are absorbed, then the interactions below may be possible.

Storage: Keep this medicine in the container in which it came, tightly closed and out of the reach of children. Store it at room temperature and away from excessive heat and moisture (not in the bathroom). Neomycin may become discolored, but this change does not affect its action.

Dosage: as directed by the physician.

Store in a cool, dry place. Protect from light.

Do not freeze. For external use only.

Keep out of reach of children.
