

OMEPRAZOLE

Omeprazole Gastro-Resistant Capsules BP 20 mg

COMPOSITION:

Each Hard Gelatin Capsule Contains:

Omeprazole BP.....20 mg

Excipients.....q.s.

Approved colour used in empty capsule shell.

Action: OMEPRAZOLE suppresses gastric acid secretion by specific inhibition of the enzyme H.K'AT pase present on the secretory surface of the gastric cell. This blocks the final and common step in gastric acid secretion.

Both basal and simulated acid secretions are inhibited irrespective of the stimulus. Peptic activity is reduced. If suppresses pylori.

Indication: Duodenal and gastric ulcer, retux or ulcerative oesophagitis, zollinger — Ellison syndrome. NSAID-induced ulcers.

Contra indication: Hypersensitivity Neonates.

Dosage: As directed by the Physician.

Side Effects: Skin rash, nausea, headache, diarrhea, constipation and flatulence. Increased risk of enteric infections due to reduced acid secretion.

Drug Interactions: Prolongs elimination of diazepam, warfarin, phenytoin, aminophylline, antitrypsin.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry and dark place, below 30°C.

Do not chew or crush the capsules, They should be swallowed whole with water.

Keep the medicine out of reach of children.
