



Ophthalmic Drops  
**Diclofenac Sodium Ophthalmic Solution**  
**0.1% w/v**

**Composition:**

Each ml contains :

Diclofenac Sodium BP ..... 0.1% w/v

Benzalkonium

Chloride Solution BP ..... 0.01% v/v

(As Preservative)

Sterile Aqueous base ..... q.s.

**Indication:** Diclofenac drops are used for: Treatment of pain, redness, swelling and sensitivity to light after certain eye surgeries. It may also be used for other conditions as determined by your doctor. Diclofenac drops are a non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drug.

**Side effects:** If any of these symptoms become troublesome or if you notice anything other than those mentioned here, go and consult your doctor.

**Notes and Precautions: Stop use if you notice:**

- \* Allergic reactions in your eyes, such as red itchy and swollen eyes and eyelids.
- \* Other general symptoms of an allergic reaction, such as rash, redness, itching, coughing, and stuffy or stuffy nose.

**Other special warnings**

- The eye drops contain benzalkonium chloride as a preservative. This can sometimes irritate the eyes. If you wear contact lenses, remove them before you use the eye drops and do not put them back in for at least 15 minutes. Soft contact lenses should not come into contact with benzalkonium chloride. They may become discolored.
- If you are using more than one type of eye drops, leave five minutes between applications.

**Storage:** Store at 20°C to 25°C.
